

What is provided with Board?

I have been asked what exactly is provided with board. I'm going to review it here and if you have any questions please feel free to ask me.

Grain: I provide sufficient grain for maintaining the body weight of the average horse under light riding conditions.

- Safechoice requires $\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ a lb of grain per 100 lbs of body weight for this level of activity.
- Enrich 32 is fed to the easy keepers at the rate of 1 lb per day for the average size horse. Mini's get $\frac{1}{4}$ a lb per day.
- Senior is fed to the older horses upon Owner's request. I will feed up to 4 lbs a day of this grain before charging additional grain amounts.
- Beet Pulp is fed to the horse that need a little more to eat or to horses that are picky about eating their supplements. I will feed up to 4 cups of beet pulp daily free of charge.

I provide garlic and Fastrack Probiotics daily to all horses free of charge.

Hay: I will supply 1 round bale per horse per field in the summer time. I will provide 2 round bales per horse per field in the winter time. (put out every 2 weeks). I will provide 1 flake of hay per mini per day of square bales. Hay type will be of a non fescue type. Lesson horse pastures will get additional hay if needed to cover their work load. If round bales are not available I will feed 1% to 2% of body weight of the horse in hay per day. (The recommended amount per most feed bags)

Supplements: I will feed any supplements provided or you may purchase one of the ones that I provide. If you have several supplements to be fed I do prefer that you order thru Smartpakequine.com so that I have an easier time getting feeds ready.

Feedings: I currently feed grain 1 time per day. If you want your horse fed more than once then it is at a fee of \$3.00 per day (according to the contract)

Holding for Services: I do not charge to hold for any service one of my own horses are getting. (Vet, Farrier, or Chiropractor) there is a \$10.00 fee to setup an appointment and hold for your horse if mine are not being seen. The only exception to this rule is I will not charge to hold for the vet if it is an emergency.

Blanketing: I will gladly blanket or un-blanket your horse if you provide a blanket. If you do not want this done that is ok too.

Worming: All new boarding contracts after 3-1-09 have worming included with board. If your contract is before this time and you do not want to upgrade to the new contract I will worm bi-monthly for the fee of \$10 and every February there will be a fee of \$55 for a Power Pack worming.

Farrier: All new boarding contracts after 3-1-09 have trims from the farrier included. If your contract is before this time and you do not want to upgrade to the new contract your fee will be \$40 per visit per horse or \$20 per visit per mini.

Medication: I will gladly medicate your horse daily. I will do this during feeding time. If your horse requires more than once medication you may do one and I will do one or depending on the treatment needed I will charge a small fee to do it more than one time per day. If your horse requires soaking by the hose for an injury there will be a fee of \$1.00 per day to cover the excess water used.

Bathing: Please feel free to use the hose in the front or back yard to bath your horse. There is no additional fee for this service. Please use a bucket with suds and don't leave water running when not hosing your horse.

If you have any special needs please ask. I'm willing to work with you in any way possible to keep horse ownership costs affordable. I try to take the best care of all horses.
